Upon receipt of all abstracts submitted by the deadline, approximately 3-4 will be selected for presentation at the meeting (with one possible alternate), and those selected will be notified by March 24, 2009. All selected final presentations must be in PowerPoint format, with length not to exceed 15 minutes, and allowing 3-5 minutes for questions and preparation for the following speaker. All students who submit abstracts but are not selected for presentation at the meeting are encouraged to create a poster or other still graphic presentation for display at the meeting event.
